Policy Regarding Leave of Absence and the Requirements for Maintaining Continuing Competency in Neonatal Resuscitation and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation

If a registered general member is on a leave of absence from clinical practice but is maintaining her registration and meeting the requirements for active practice under sections **5.-(1)** through **5.-(3)**, she is not required to maintain her continuing competence in neonatal resuscitation and cardiopulmonary resuscitation under section **4.-(5)** while on the leave of absence. The member must notify the Registrar, in writing, of the date that the leave of absence will begin. The member must inform the Registrar, in writing, of her return to practice and must provide the Registrar with evidence of her current certification in both neonatal resuscitation and cardiopulmonary resuscitation at the point of return to clinical practice.
