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## **POLICY ON CONTINUING COMPETENCY IN NEONATAL RESUSCITATION**

The midwife will be annually certified in neonatal resuscitation. The required standard of performance is completion of a course that meets or exceeds the Canadian Paediatric Society's Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) as it applies within the midwife's scope of practice.

Where a midwife is a certified NRP instructor she will be considered to have met the above requirement when she provides evidence of:

- a) a current NRP instructor's certificate; and
- b) having taught at least one NRP course in the previous twelve months.
