POLICY ON THE DEMONSTRATION OF LANGUAGE FLUENCY

An applicant for registration must demonstrate the ability to communicate with reasonable fluency in either French or English in one of three ways:

1. By providing evidence of a passing score on the Ontario Midwifery Language Proficiency Test (MLPT)

OR

2. By providing evidence of successful completion of a Canadian Baccalaureate Degree in Midwifery in which the language of instruction for both academic and clinical portions was either French or English.

OR

3. By providing evidence of eligibility for registration under the provisions of the Midwifery Mutual Recognition Agreement.
