## **NOTICE:**

The **CANADIAN MIDWIFERY REGISTRATION EXAMINATION** is scheduled to take place on:

### **May 2, 2019**

Deadline for registration – March 8, 2019  
Withdrawal deadline – April 5, 2019

### **May 7, 2020**

Deadline for registration – March 13, 2020  
Withdrawal deadline – April 10, 2020

### **October 31, 2019**

Deadline for registration – September 6, 2019  
Withdrawal deadline – October 1, 2019

### **October 29, 2020**

Deadline for registration – September 7, 2020  
Withdrawal deadline – September 30, 2020

*Note: The CMRE takes place on the first Thursday of May and last Thursday of October unless this date is a statutory holiday.*

The CMRE is open to candidates that meet one of the following criteria: Successfully completed or currently enrolled in good standing in the final term of a Canadian Baccalaureate Midwifery Education Program approved or recognized by one of the provincial/territorial midwifery regulatory colleges;

OR

Successfully completed or currently enrolled in good standing in the final stage\*<sup>1</sup> of a Canadian bridging or gap training program approved or recognized by one of the provincial/territorial midwifery regulatory colleges;

OR

A decision from a Canadian provincial/territorial midwifery regulator PLEA process that indicates they are approved to write the CMRE.

*Note: Proof of eligibility must be provided by the Midwifery Education Programs, the bridging or gap training programs or the provincial/territorial midwifery regulators where applicable.*

### **Late registrations are not accepted.**

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<sup>1</sup> Final stage in the International Midwifery Preregistration Program (IMMP) and the Manitoba Assessment and Gap Training Program refers to once the 'Definitive Assessment' has been completed and the candidate has been deemed eligible to continue.

Final stage in the Internationally Educated Midwives Bridging Program (IEMBP) refers to once part 1 and 2 of the IEM Bridging Program has been successfully completed and the candidate has received an overall P (Passing) standing during the midterm of their Part 3 clinical practicum Evaluation.

Final stage in the UQTR Programme D'appointe refers to once the candidate has entered into the clinical practicum (la stage).
