The CMRE is open to candidates that meet one of the following criteria:

- Successfully completed or currently enrolled in good standing in the final term of a Canadian Baccalaureate Midwifery Education Program (MEP) approved or recognized by the provincial/territorial midwifery Regulatory Organization;
OR
- Successfully completed or currently enrolled in good standing in the final stage^{*1} of a Canadian bridging or gap training program approved or recognized by the provincial/territorial midwifery Regulatory Organization;
OR
- A decision from a Canadian provincial/territorial midwifery regulator PLEA process that indicates they are approved to write the CMRE.

Late registrations are not accepted

¹ *Final stage in the International Midwifery Preregistration Program (IMMP) and the Manitoba Assessment and Gap Training Program refers to once the 'Definitive Assessment' has been completed and the candidate has been deemed eligible to continue.*

Final stage in the UQTR Programme D'appointe refers to the point in time when the candidate has entered into the clinical practicum (la stage).
